

Data protection policy

Thank you for visiting our website and your interest in our company. Protecting your personal data is important to us. Personal data is individual details about personal or factual relationships of a definite or identifiable person. This includes information such as civic name, address, telephone number and date of birth.

As this data is subject to special protection, it will only be collected by us to the extent of and in accordance with the regulations required for technical purposes. Below we set out which information we gather during your visit to our site and how it is used.

Our data protection policy is in accordance with the provisions of the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and Telemedia Act (TMG) as well as the Maltese Data Protection Act (Chapter 440). We will only collect, process and store your personal data for dealing with inquiries and, where applicable, processing orders/agreements. Your data is only used for additional purposes specified precisely in the consent, such as information about offers via our newsletter, with your prior consent.

2. Anonymous/pseudonymized use of the website

You are always able to visit our website without providing personal data. Pseudonymized usage data is not mixed with the pseudonym carrier's data. Pseudonymized usage profiles are not created.

3. Specific functions of the website

Our site offers you various functions where personal data is collected, processed and stored by us when they are used. What happens with this data is set out below:

- **Contact form:**

We will only use data collected via our contact form for processing inquiries via the contact form. Once the inquiry has been dealt with, the data is immediately deleted unless a statutory retention period applies.

- **Login area:**

You have the option of using a separate login area on our website. Where you have forgotten your username or password for this area, there is the option of having these details resent where you have entered your contact details (email address) in advance. Any login area usage data is only collected, stored and processed by us to tackle misuse and rectify malfunctions or, as may apply, maintain functionality. It is not used for other purposes or disclosed to third parties. Data collected as part of the 'Forgotten Username/Password' function is only used for resending forgotten access details.

4. Data forwarding / purpose

We only disclose personal data to third parties where required for performing our contractual obligations or regulatory requirements, in particular for progressing an agreement entered into or for compliance with provisions within the framework of gaming legislation. Personal data is not disclosed to third parties other than for the stated purposes and for purchase processing.

If you provide us with personal data with express consent, this data is only used for the purpose underpinning the consent and that you have agreed to in advance. We will only store your personal data for as long as necessary for the intended purpose of the data collection or as set out by law. You are entitled to revoke your consent at any time.

Your interests to be protected are borne in mind in accordance with statutory provisions. You are able to obtain information about stored data concerning you from the relevant office.

5. Consent to the disclosure of personal data when opening a customer account (Schufa account number check plus IBAN consent)

Upon opening a customer account, the customer's personal data is collected and checked, to identify the customer and to verify bank account information.

By sending the registration form, the customer gives consent to IBA Entertainment Ltd. to forward personal data and banking information (particularly IBAN or bank identification number and account number) to SCHUFA Holding AG, Kormoranweg 5, 65201 Wiesbaden, to check the account number, and SCHUFA will first use this information to check that the information provided to the bank is plausible. The customer also agrees for this data to be used for verification, whether the data is stored in the SCHUFA database or not, and the results of these checks are then sent back to IBA Entertainment Ltd.

Any further exchanges of data, such as providing credit information, transmitting any deviating bank data, or saving customer data in the SCHUFA database will NOT take place within the framework of account number verification. Any data is only saved at SCHUFA as proof of evidence only for verifying bank account details.

6. Statistical evaluation of visits to this website

When this website or individual files thereof are called up we collect, process and store the following data: IP address, website from which the file was called up, name of the file, date and time called up, amount of data transferred and web log report. We only use these access details in a non-personal form to constantly improve our online product and for statistical purposes.

We also use the following plugins and active script content to analyze visits to this website:

- Google Analytics:

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service of Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA (hereinafter: Google). Google Analytics uses various techniques such as, among others, 'cookies' stored on your computer allowing analysis of the use of

this website by visitors. Information obtained by Google Analytics via the use of this website is sent to Google servers operated, as applies, in states other than Member States of the European Union and, as applies, also states other than those signatory to the European Economic Area Treaty. Your IP address is sent anonymously by activating IP anonymization within this website's Google Analytics tracking codes. - Pingdom

Our website uses Pingdom, a service provided by Pingdom AB, Kopparbergsvägen 8, 72213 Västerås, Sweden. Pingdom uses, among other things, cookies stored on your computer allowing use of the website to be analyzed. When used, data such as in particular user activity and IP address are sent to and stored on a Pingdom AB server. Where required, Pingdom AB will send this information to third parties provided this is allowed for by law or where this data is processed by third parties. You are able to prevent personal data (in particular your IP address) from being collected, forwarded and processed by disabling Java Script from running on your browser or installing a tool such as 'NoScript'. 8. Information about using cookies

We use cookies on various sites to make visiting our website attractive and allow specific functions to be used.
